Project criteria:

- must be for a non-profit organization.
- must be for public use.
- a current design plan with a plant and materials list, preferably prepared by an NHLA member, is to be submitted with the application.
- a time line of materials acquisitions and work items must be provided.
- project area should be of high to moderate visibility.
- soliciting organization or business must provide the following forms of assistance throughout the project:
 - project manager
 - necessary public relations
 - physical labor during the designated work day
- scope of NHLA's physical involvement should not exceed one to two days of work
- it is the duty of the soliciting organization or business to see that the completed project is properly maintained and cared for.
